



Pass Plus

with Accelerate Driver Training

Pass Plus is an official course created and supported by the Driving Standards Agency aimed at New Drivers reducing road accidents, injuries and deaths by:

- Improving your current skills
- Gain more experience
- Experiencing new, farther afield road situations
- Benefit from Insurance discounts, with companies who recognise PASS PLUS benefits.

Pass Plus is made up of six practical modules which include:

- ✚ Driving in town
- ✚ Driving in all weathers
- ✚ Driving on rural roads
- ✚ Driving at night
- ✚ Driving on dual carriageways
- ✚ Driving on motorways

Anyone who holds a full UK licence is eligible to take part in the scheme; although it's mainly aimed at new drivers aged 17-21. Course duration is minimum, and typically, 6 hours. We can do it in a day, with appropriate breaks (allow 7 hours or so, total).

There's no test.

You must successfully complete all the modules in the course to an achieved or exceeded standard through your Instructor's assessment during the course. On completion of the

course you will receive a Pass Certificate from the Driving Standards Agency. You'll need this to benefit from insurance discounts.

These are the 6 modules:



Town driving

Driving in town can be daunting: rush hour traffic, complicated junctions and one-way traffic systems...learn the skills to deal with all these and more. We'll visit Newcastle for this module



All-weather driving

Rain, fog, bright sunshine, floods, snow and ice. Find out how to drive safely in all the different weather conditions you'll face on the road.

We'll also offer a skid pan experience for this type of driving (this is extra to Pass Plus course and is available to any driver)



Driving out of town

Country roads can harbour all kinds of hazards. From sharp bends, blind summits, single track lanes with passing places and potholes to farm vehicles and animals in the road these are very challenging roads. Crashes with new drivers are often on these roads. We'll travel over to Cumbria or North Yorkshire for this.



Night driving

Dealing with dazzle, judging distance and speed, using your lights correctly. These are just some of the areas covered, on all types of roads.



Driving on dual carriageways

To drive safely on fast, multi-lane roads you'll need all your skills of observation, concentration, anticipation and lane discipline. You will have driven on local dual carriageways, but we'll go farther afield on your **Pass Plus** Course



Driving on Motorways

Motorways are like no other roads. More lanes, different road signs, different rules. Learn how to drive on them safely and correctly under expert supervision. Most drivers have had no motorway tuition – and it shows! Do it safely, do it right, with us. We'll use A1(M) or M6 for this module.

Journey planning, using maps, the internet and sat-nav will be covered, as will vehicle preparation in respect of longer journeys.

Regular, basic vehicle checks are already covered within your lessons as a learner.
